Expert physical activity ambassador

Objective and mandate:

FitSpirit is looking for an ambassador with expertise in the field of physical activity and healthy lifestyle promotion, as well as experience in physical activity counselling. Her mandate is to provide support to communities (program leaders, participants, other ambassadors) in terms of physical activities, sports, and the outdoors. She will also participate in certain activities to represent the organization (FitSpirit tour, video capsules).

Reporting to the Director of Programs, and in close collaboration with the Programs and Evaluations Advisor and the programs team, the expert physical activity ambassador will have varying mandates and tasks that will change significantly throughout the year. She must also be available for some trips across Canada.

The chosen candidate must:

- Have a good command of both oral and written French and English;
- Have a bachelor's degree in a field related to physical activity (kinesiology, teacher in health and physical education etc.);
- Possess relevant experience in leading a variety of physical activities;
- Be able to work independently;
- Be able to adjust one's level of language and interventions based on the audience (adolescents, teachers, other ambassadors);
- Be able to show leadership in coordinating a small team;
- Previous experience as a FitSpirit Ambassador or employee is an asset.

Main tasks :

- Participate and coordinate the FitSpirit Introduction Tour in-field from different Canadian provinces. The project will require travel in the spring of 2019 (with the intention to renew the tour in Fall 2019).
- Participate in the development and filming of video capsules for FitSpirit leaders and participants.
- During the school year, respond to emails from teachers and participants about Physical Activity and various FitSpirit activities.
- Participate in the animation of Facebook groups to feed the community with ideas that encourage young girls to move more, with pleasure.
